SMARTIE FAQs

What is SMARTIE?

SMARTIE is the **S**tudy to **M**easure **A**dvanced **P**ractitioner **R**etention of **T**argeted **I**nformation and **E**ducation. It is an educational outcomes initiative designed to assess the impact of the education presented during the JADPRO Live conference.

Why is the SMARTIE Study important?

Outcomes measurement is an essential part of assessing the impact of continuing medical education on patient care. At JADPRO Live, we are committed to meeting the educational needs of our audience by understanding how well the concepts conveyed here help advanced practitioners in oncology in their practice. Direct feedback from the audience is the only way we can learn whether a presentation's learning objectives were met.

What are the benefits of being a SMARTIE participant?

Depending on the previous level of involvement, SMARTIE participants (SMARTIEs) receive a substantial discount to attend the JADPRO Live conference. Currently, new SMARTIEs receive a 75% discount off their conference tuition, and returning SMARTIEs who fully completed the program last year receive a 100% discount. Harborside™ (the producer of the JADPRO Live conference) reserves the right to change the discount amounts on a yearly basis.

SMARTIEs are also satisfied knowing that they are actively and effectively impacting the quality of education at the meeting, which will improve their professional development and ultimately lead to better patient outcomes.

What are the requirements of being a SMARTIE?

SMARTIEs are required to do the following:

- Fully register for and attend this year's JADPRO Live conference
- Respond to a pre-conference survey to evaluate your baseline knowledge on select topics that will be presented at the conference
- Respond to post-session surveys after selected sessions
- Respond to a post-conference practice survey (about 3–6 months after the conference) evaluating how you have incorporated the knowledge you gained at the conference into your practice.

If you complete all the requirements, you will be eligible to be a SMARTIE again next year and will receive an invitation via email. Decisions on what the requirements are and/or who will be a SMARTIE may change without notice and are the sole discretion of Harborside.

How much time will I need to dedicate to complete the SMARTIE requirements?

Completing the pre-conference questions can take some as few as 15 minutes, but it will take some over an hour. For most, it will take approximately 30 to 45 minutes.

Completing each individual post-session question set will take an average of 5 to 10 minutes each (as a reference, there were 8 sets in 2018).

Completing the post-conference practice survey (i.e., the "follow-up" survey), sent 3 to 6 months afterwards, will take about 30 minutes to 1 hour.

What if I don't complete my pre-conference questions? Can I still be a SMARTIE? Can I still attend the conference at the discounted rate?

No. If you don't complete your pre-conference questions before the conference starts (or if you no longer want to be a SMARTIE), you are not eligible to be a SMARTIE and you will need to pay the applicable amount in order to gain access to the conference sessions.

I've never been a SMARTIE before but am interested in becoming one. Do I qualify? How do I become one?

Any JADPRO Live attendee who is an active clinician in oncology who maintains an active clinic schedule is eligible to be a SMARTIE. Please go to jadprolive.com/smartie. This will take you to the SMARTIE application page. Once you fill out the info there, agree to the terms and hit submit, you're a SMARTIE for this year's conference! However, space in the program is limited and enrollment will close each year at the discretion of Harborside.

I signed up to be a SMARTIE, but have not received the registration discount code. What happened?

Once you submit the online form, as long as you actively see patients, the registration system automatically deploys an email with your code to the email address you used when signing up. If you did not receive an email, it may have gone to your spam folder (please check there). Please

check that the spam settings in your mailbox accept emails from JADPRO@hbside.com, and info@harborsidepress.com.

I was a SMARTIE last year. How do I get my discount for this year?

If you completed the requirements for the SMARTIE program last year, you will receive an email invite for the current year. Harborside reserves the right to change what the requirements are on a yearly basis. You will receive specific information about the exact discount amount you qualify for in advance of the conference. Decisions on what the requirements are to be a SMARTIE may change without notice and is at the sole discretion of Harborside. If you did not complete the minimum amount of requirements last year and therefore didn't receive an invitation to participate again, you can still sign up anew to be a SMARTIE again; however, if you don't complete the minimum requirements yet again, you cannot be a SMARTIE in the future.
